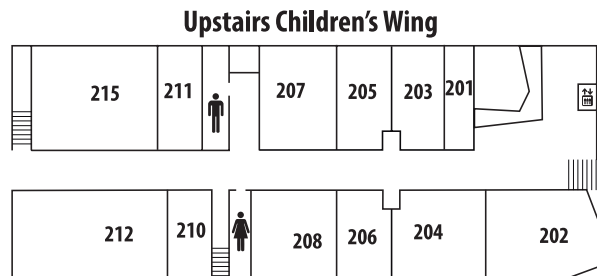
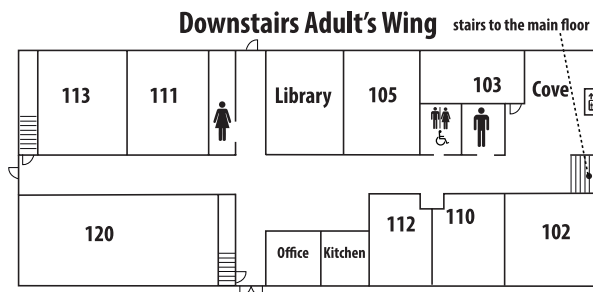
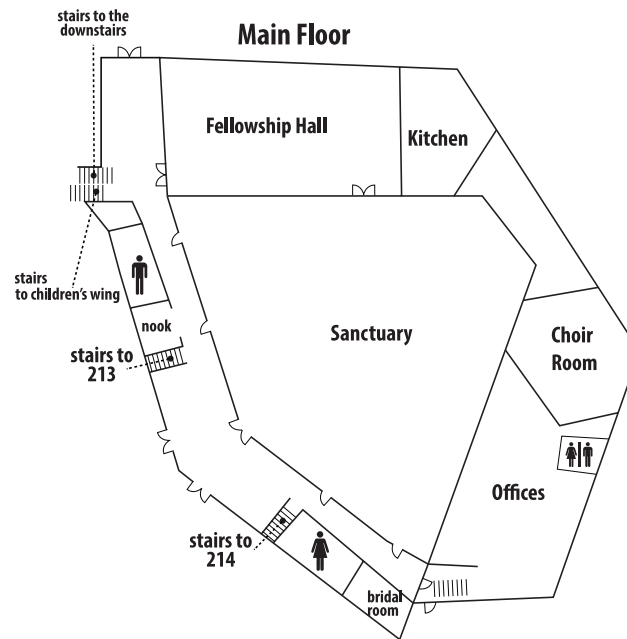

How to grow at Redeemer...

In the Great Commission of Matthew 28, Jesus commanded his disciples, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations." Christians are not only called to believe rightly about Jesus, but also to demonstrate their love for Him through obedience to His Word.

The basics of being a disciple involve three steps we call the Discipleship Pathway. First, maturing disciples **WORSHIP** God, demonstrating His supreme worth and growing in love for Him. This is done both corporately and individually. Next, maturing disciples **CONNECT** with God's people in meaningful relationships, sacrificially loving one another. And finally, maturing disciples **SERVE** others, demonstrating the love of Christ while introducing them to the Savior.
