- Pay attention to the main *Facts* of the passage.

#### WHAT DID YOU LEARN?

- What does the passage reveal about God? About people?
- Is there a promise or a command or a warning?
- What is the main truth of the passage?
- What lessons do you see?

#### **HOW WILL YOU APPLY IT?**

- How does this passage relate to your life right now?
- What change in your thinking or behavior is needed to align with the truths in this passage?
- How should you respond based on what you learned?

## From the Teaching this Morning

- How can we know if our grief over the loss of loved ones is normal or like that of those who have no hope?
- How does hope differ from faith and love? How is it unique; what is its distinctive identity and role?
- How can we deepen our compassion for the lost?
- Why is it important to see that conversion is nothing less than God's imparting new life to dead sinners?
