- What is the main truth of the passage?
- What lessons do you see?

HOW WILL YOU APPLY IT?

- How does this passage relate to your life right now?
- What change in your thinking or behavior is needed to align with the truths in this passage?
- · How should you respond based on what you learned?

From the Teaching this Morning

- In 1 John 4, John mentions three times (vv. 7, 11, 21) the command for believers to love one another. In what ways have you seen this lived out at RBC? How have you personally experienced this?
- In what ways would you encourage yourself and the people of RBC to continue to grow in our love for each other? How can this be accomplished?
