WHAT IS THE PASSAGE ABOUT?

- Note the key details (Who, What, When, Where, Why, etc.)
- Pay attention to the main *Facts* of the passage.

WHAT DID YOU LEARN?

- What does the passage reveal about God? About people?
- Is there a promise or a command or a warning?
- What is the main truth of the passage?
- What lessons do you see?

HOW WILL YOU APPLY IT?

- How does this passage relate to your life right now?
- What change in your thinking or behavior is needed to align with the truths in this passage?
- How should you respond based on what you learned?

1. What are you particularly anxious about these days, for which God is waiting on you to call on his name and acknowledge your need?
2. How can you make God your dwelling place or your refuge in times of trouble?
3. Read verses 14 -16. What two keys to deliverance are given in verse 14?
 - a. What description is given of the refuge God promises to provide?
 - b. Verse 15 talks about calling upon the Lord. Where else in the Bible does it talk about this? Read Matt. 7:7-8.
 - c. Man's most urgent need is deliverance from eternal judgment and separation from God's presence forever. Read Rom. 10:9-13.
