Static Questions

WHAT IS THE PASSAGE ABOUT?

- Note the key details (Who, What, When, Where, Why, etc.)
- Pay attention to the main *Facts* of the passage.

WHAT DID YOU LEARN?

- What does the passage reveal about God? About people?
- Is there a promise or a command or a warning?
- What is the main truth of the passage?
- What lessons do you see?

HOW WILL YOU APPLY IT?

- How does this passage relate to your life right now?
- What change in your thinking or behavior is needed to align with the truths in this passage?
- How should you respond based on what you learned?

From the Teaching this Morning

- 1. What are you particularly anxious about these days, for which God is waiting on you to call on his name and acknowledge your need?
- 2. How can you make God your dwelling place or your refuge in times of trouble?
- 3. Read verses 14-16. What two keys to deliverance are given in verse 14? a. What description is given of the refuge God promises to provide?
 - b. Verse 15 talks about calling upon the Lord. Where else in the Bible does it talk about this? Read Matt. 7:7-8.
 - c. Man's most urgent need is deliverance from eternal judgment and separation from God's presence forever. Read Rom. 10:9-13.
