Getting Started

Static Questions

- What was the passage about?
 - o Note the key details (Who, What, When, Where, Why, etc.)
 - Pay attention to the main points of the passage.
- What did you learn?
 - O What did the passage reveal about God? About people?
 - O Was there a promise or command or a warning?
 - O What is the big idea of the passage?
 - O What lessons do you see?
- How will you apply it?
 - O How does this passage relate to your life right now?
 - What change in your thinking or behavior is needed to align with the truths in this message?
 - O How should you respond based on what you learned?

From the Teaching this Morning

- What does it mean that Jesus serves as our Great High Priest? What implications have does this have for our walk of discipleship?
- How does knowing Christ endured temptation overcame help us on our path of discipleship?
- What do you think prevents us from approaching the throne with confidence?
- How does knowing God has promised to provide mercy and grace to help in time of need help us on our path of discipleship?

Application Questions

- What is it easy for us to place our confidence instead of in Christ?
 - Pray that He would remind you of His supremecy and sufficiency and then spend time in worship of Him!
