 - \circ Note the key details (Who, What, When, Where, Why, etc.)
 - Pay attention to the main *points* of the passage.
- What did you learn?
 - What did the passage reveal about God? About people?
 - Was there a promise or command or a warning?
 - What is the big idea of the passage?
 - What lessons do you see?
- How will you apply it?
 - How does this passage relate to your life right now?
 - What change in your thinking or behavior is needed to align with the truths in this message?
 - How should you respond based on what you learned?

From the Teaching this Morning

- What aspects of Ruth's character draw us to the character of God? How does God use that in the life of Naomi?
- In what areas of your life do you struggle to see God as good even if you do see Him as sovereign? Why do you think that is?
- Why do you think the author does not blatantly show us that God is the one behind everything going on? (i.e. the famine, the timing, etc).
