Who is walking with you?: Elijah-Elisha

II Kings 2

Getting Started

- When you think back on your walk with God, what physical locations come to mind? (This could be the location where you gave your life to Christ, or where you were baptized, or where you would meet with a disciple, etc.). Share what those locations were with each other and what specific memories come to mind when you think of those places.

Static Questions

- **What was the passage about?**
 - Note the key details (Who, What, When, Where, Why, etc.)
 - Pay attention to the main *points* of the passage.
- **What did you learn?**
 - What did the passage reveal about God? About people?
 - Was there a promise or command or a warning?
 - What is the big idea of the passage?
 - What lessons do you see?
- **How will you apply it?**
 - How does this passage relate to your life right now?
 - What change in your thinking or behavior is needed to align with the truths in this message?
 - How should you respond based on what you learned?

From the Teaching this Morning

- What is a disciple? What is discipleship? How are we as a church doing at discipling?
- Were there people in your life that invited you to come alongside them that helped you learn about discipleship?
- What are common excuses we make for not making disciples? What are the truths and the lies about those excuses?

Application Questions

- What are ways your group can go out and serve together?
 - What are the benefits of serving together?
 - If possible (and if the group is comfortable) work on putting something on the calendar for when you can go out and serve together.
- Pray for people to disciple you and for people to disciple
 - If this is already taking place, take time daily to pray for your disciplers/disciples
