Getting Started

- When was a time the Lord allowed you to enter a “fire” and He revealed His faithful presence to you amidst that trial? Or maybe it did it not seem like He revealed Himself?

Static Questions

- **What was the passage about?**
 - Note the key details (Who, What, When, Where, Why, etc.)
 - Pay attention to the main *points* of the passage.
- **What did you learn?**
 - What did the passage reveal about God? About people?
 - Was there a promise or command or a warning?
 - What is the big idea of the passage?
 - What lessons do you see?
- **How will you apply it?**
 - How does this passage relate to your life right now?
 - What change in your thinking or behavior is needed to align with the truths in this message?
 - How should you respond based on what you learned?

From the Teaching this Morning

- What is there in our specific church setting that we can be tempted to exalt before God? How can we resist this temptation?
- What are promises of God you find yourself regularly going back to that encourage you amidst hardship?
- Who are individuals who have shown you “the fourth man in the fire” through the way they handled hardship?

Application Questions

- Who are specific individuals that you know are going through great trial, hardship and/or persecution right now? What are ways you can walk with them through that trial?
- Pray for the people who give you the hardest time for your faith.
