  - O What is the big idea of the passage?
  - o What lessons do you see?
- How will you apply it?
  - O How does this passage relate to your life right now?
  - o What change in your thinking or behavior is needed to align with the truths in this message?
  - o How should you respond based on what you learned?

- 1. Read Romans 12:6-8 and I Peter 4:10-11 about using spiritual gifts. What will be the impact on the church body if a believer does NOT exercise his or her gift?
