- O What is the main truth of the passage?
- o What lessons do you see?

HOW WILL YOU APPLY IT?

- o How does this passage relate to your life right now?
- o What change in your thinking or behavior is needed to align with the truths in this passage?
- o How should you respond based on what you learned?

Discussion

- Is there a difference between <u>being glad</u> and <u>rejoicing</u>?
- In your opinion, what distinguishes rejoicing in the Lord from any other kind of rejoicing?
- The "concision" group (3:2) regularly performs rituals and ceremonies. How can these be used effectively without becoming mere superficial practices?
