Getting Started

- Have you ever been hesitant to do something, only to find out later that God had already provided what you need for you to do it?

Static Questions

- **WHAT IS THE PASSAGE ABOUT?**
 - Note the key details (Who, What, When, Where, Why, etc.)
 - Pay attention to the main Facts of the passage.
- **WHAT DID YOU LEARN?**
 - What does the passage reveal about God? About people?
 - Is there a promise or a command or a warning?
 - What is the main truth of the passage?
 - What lessons do you see?
- **HOW WILL YOU APPLY IT?**
 - How does this passage relate to your life right now?
 - What change in your thinking or behavior is needed to align with the truths in this passage?
 - How should you respond based on what you learned?

Discussion

- Have you ever had a frustrating experience, but another person helped by telling you something like, "Lean back on your security and work with both hands!"
- Did you learn anything new in today's message? Was there something in the message that was not new to you, but was either reinforced or presented in a way that was helpful to you?
- Of the provisions God has made to cover your sin issues, which was most interesting to you?
- What was of interest to you in the "put off / put on" and the "put to death" passages?
- Which subject, topic, or passage mentioned today would you like to learn more about?
